Introduction



- On the 14th of May, 2017, Missionaries from across Nigeria embarked on a two (2) weeks outreach to Obafemi Awolowo University Campus, Ile-Ife, Osun State
- The main mission started with above 100 volunteers within the first week.
- Volunteers travelled from Abia, Abuja, Edo/Delta, Cross-River, Plateau, Kaduna, Lagos, Rivers States to Osun State to reach out to dying souls.
- Volunteers consisted of Secondary school leavers, Undergraduates students, Graduate Professionals, Farmers, Lecturers, Lawyers, Teachers, and even Elders of the SDA Church.

Ground Breaking



- The Ground-breaking activities lasted 6 weeks. It started on the 6th of April, 2017 and ended on the 14th of May, 2017.
- At the beginning of the ground-breaking, there were 3 Volunteers drawn from all the country. However, more volunteers joined making a total of 19 volunteers at the end.

Health Expo



- The Health Expo ran for 2 weeks, beginning 14th of May 2017 – 26th of May, 2017
- The Health Expo started five days before the Evangelistic campaign began and lasted all through the program.
- The Health Expo program consisted of two sections:
 - ✓ Daily health lectures: Which were delivered from 9am-11am.
 - ✓ Daily health screening: The health screening commenced from 12pm

Two-By-Two



- Every day, the missionaries were sent out in pairs to homes, hostels, shops and offices to share the Three Angels' messages with the people of OAU Community.
- An average of 68 Bible studies were given on a daily basis to the community.
- An average of 134 people were prayed for each day during the two-by-two evangelism and invitation calls were extended to these people to attend the evening program.
- The two-by-two evangelism lasted for 3 hours daily.



Bus Evangelism



- The bus evangelism method was used to invite people for the program and share tracts.
- About 15 volunteers were deployed for this line of Bible work.
- Over 1590 tracts, flyers and handbills were given out daily.
- They employed the use of mobile public address system and stopped at strategic parts of the campus.

Prospect Call Centre (PCC)



- Some missionaries were assigned to call visitors, prospects and newly baptized members on a daily basis.
- They prayed on the phone and encouraged the visitors who had previously attended the program to keep coming.
- They also sent good will messages by SMS.
- An average of 220 calls were made daily.
- About 1645 pages of SMS were sent daily.

Media Evangelism(Radio Jingles & Interviews)



- There were daily radio jingles on the OAU Campus mission.
- This created a massive awareness within the campus.
- The mission jingles were aired on Crown FM:101.5 48 times lasting about two minutes.
- Radio interviews were granted 3 times. 15 minutes for each interview

Morning Excellence Series Meetings



- Every morning, from 22nd of May - 26th of May, 2017 an average of 6 prospects came out to listen to the Excellence Series presented at Main-bowl, Sports Complex, OAU daily.
- Life changing words were spoken by Pastor Godswill MENSAH through the inspired word of God on how we can be excellent in our various spheres of life.
- The morning program was streamed live, so that people all over the world were able to watch the program. Social media such as Instagram and twitter were also used to broadcast the message.



Evening Evangelistic Meetings



- Every night, from the 19th of May - 26th of May, 2017 an average of 85 adult guests came out to listen to the Word of God proclaimed at Amphitheatre.
- Before the evening sermon began, a short health talk was delivered. The health talks were delivered by Dr. Atolagbe, one of our Medical Missionaries.
- The evening program was streamed live, so that people all over the world were able to watch the program. Social media such as Instagram and twitter were also used to broadcast the message.
- Light refreshment (fruits) was served to all visiting friends after each evening session.

Praying Without Ceasing



- Missionaries were encouraged to pray with at least 5 people everyday.
- Volunteers found physical, spiritual and mental strength through prayers and trusting in God. Solutions to many problems came solely through the power of prayers.
- ALIVE-Nigeria members who couldn't attend the missions, formed a 24/7 prayer chain. They prayed round the clock for 2 weeks. Each of them praying for thirty minutes on the forum each day.



MEAL TIMES

- Meal times were happy times.
- Vegetarian meals were served twice everyday.
- Food items were donated by missionaries. They sourced what food items they could from their various locations.
- Some missionaries volunteered to serve as official Caterers for ALIVE-Nigeria. They prepared our very tasty and healthy vegetarian meals.
- The caterers also taught missionaries how to prepare vegetarian meals.



SABBATH WORSHIP



- During the Sabbath School worship, we had several study units and a separate class for our prospects and baptismal candidates.
- Sabbath worship was blessed with numerous visitors.
- Visiting friends thought the pastor's class to be very engaging, as they had the time to interact closely and discuss doctrinal questions.

BAPTISM



- To the glory of God, OAU Campus Mission witnessed the baptism of 52 souls who gladly joined the Remnant SDA Church in Nigeria.
- Two mobile baptistery was used for the baptism.
- Baptisms were conducted on the 26th and 27th of May, 2017.
- The newly baptized members received their certificate, and their gifts (Bible, steps to Christ and study pack) on the 27th of May, 2017.

NEWLY BAPTIZED

- Some Long Term Missionaries (LTMs) sponsored by ALIVE-Nigeria and a few volunteers stayed back to nurture the newly baptized brethren for a few months. The Adventist Student Fellowship also promised to nurture the new members and grant them all the support they will need to the best of their ability.
