INTRODUCTION

By the special grace of God, ALIVE-Nigeria engaged herself in the month of May, 2014 on a 3 weeks outreach to two communities in Enugu state- Eke and Affa.

The mission started with the arrival of 27 volunteers on the 1st day and eventually increased to 66 volunteers. Volunteers came from Anambra, Aba, Lagos, Port Harcourt, Owerri, Jos and Abuja.



INSIGHT ABOUT AFFA & EKE ...

- □Affa and Eke communities are under Udi LGA of Enugu state. In these communities about 95% of them were staunch Catholics, with a strong influence from their priests.
- □Interestingly enough, these same Catholics were openly practising idolatry with shrines and holy hills interspersed all around the communities.
- □These people showed very little interest in Bible studies, tracts and even prayers.
- □As a result, the daily attendance of children and adults was very poor, especially in Affa where they had direct orders from their priest not to attend the meetings.

GROUND BREAKING

□ On the 20th of April, 2014, 3 weeks before the evangelistic campaigns, 5 ground breakers (Long term missionaries) arrived Affa and Eke to mix with the indigenes, make friends with them and prepare their hearts to receive the pure words of life.



GROUND BREAKING (CONT'D)

□On the 4th of May, medical missionaries arrived the camps and to the glory of God their presence had a huge impact on the success of the mission. Approximately 500 people were treated for various diseases using natural remedies and quite a number of inhabitants testified to God's healing through these natural sources.



MEDICAL MISSIONARY SERVICES

remedies used for the treatment are activated charcoal, cayenne, pepper, moringa, green tea.

TEACHING CLASSES- The medical team taught the villagers how to prepare whole wheat bread, activated

charcoal and green tea.

MORNING CRY

For several mornings by 5:30 am, the missionaries were divided into groups, to walk around the village singing choruses, praying for the indigenes and inviting them to all our programs





TRAINING SESSIONS


To equip every volunteer in the mission, we had training sessions, with excerpts from the Spirit of Prophecy. Topics like:

- > Personal Discipline
- > How to give a Bible study
- > Giving up your rights.



AT LEAST WITH FIVE

- Asides personal/group devotions and united prayer sessions, volunteers were encouraged to pray with at least 5 people everyday.
- A lot of challenges were resolved by this means; we found relieve and assurance from these moments.



TWO BY TWO WITNESSING

 Every day, we set out in pairs to homes, farms and shops to share the gospel of Christ with people.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

On 18th of May, 2014, all the missionaries set out to serve the community in 3 groups:

- Maranatha- was assigned to clean homes and roads.
- Triumphant- was assigned to clean the village square and market.
- True Revival- was assigned to fetch water.



Villagers were so thrilled at the sight of volunteers working with loud praises, that they stopped to wonder. We heard people say "these people care about us", "their message to us is complete". Many families expressed their gratitude with prayers and gifts.





WELFARE UNIT

- On 21st and 24th of May, 2014 we distributed relief materials (clothes, bags, shoes) brought by volunteers to the communities.
- ■Again by God's grace, we put smiles on the faces of the poor and needy, the widows, children and elderly.



SABBATH WORSHIP

During Sabbath school hours we had a separate class for all our visitors and baptismal candidates, so that they could freely ask all the questions that troubled them.



BAPTISM

To the glory of God, 31 souls from Affa & Eke were added to God's church.
