

AUGUST 2018 MISSION SITE



In August 2018, Close to 300 Missionaries from across Nigeria embarked on a two-week long Mission outreach to **University of** Calabar mission site in Cross River state.

INTRODUCTION

- ✓ On August 12th 2018, missionaries from across the country embarked on a two(2) week outreach at the University of Calabar.
- ✓ The main mission started with the arrival of over 250 volunteers within
 the first week of the outreach.
- ✓ Volunteers travelled from Abia, Imo, Jos, Edo, Delta, Lagos, Port Harcourt, Kaduna, Babcock and Anambra States to Cross River.
- ✓ Some of these volunteers were baptized converts from the past ALIVE-Nigeria missions sites like from Kaduna, Delta, Kogi etc
- ✓ Volunteers consisted of Secondary school leavers, undergraduate
 students, Graduate Professionals, Farmers, Lecturers, Lawyers, Teachers,
 and even Elders of the SDA Church.



MISSION VOLUNTEERS



- All the missionaries were divided into teams and each team had a team head assigned to it.
- ⚠ The mission rules were read to all the missionaries and each missionary consented to the rules by his/her signature.
- ⚠ The Mission handbook containing the daily timetable, mission rules and excerpts of EG White writings was given to each missionary on arrival.
- ⚠ The team heads were accountable to the Mission Coordinators for the behaviour and performance of their team members.

SOME INSIGHT ABOUT UniCal

- ✓ A rough estimation of the religious affiliations of the population are as follows: Islam, pagans and Christianity.
- ✓ The biggest Christian influence is Pentecostalism with the highest number of churches. These churches include: Christ Embassy The Redeemed Christian Church of God, Presbyterian, Deeper Life Bible Church.
- ✓ The populace strongly believe in the covenant of grace theology. There is also a widespread belief that miracles are indicative of God's presence.

EVENING EVANGELISTIC MEETINGS

GROUND BREAKING

- √ The Ground-breaking activities lasted 8 weeks. It started
 on the 10th June, 2018 and lasted till the 3rd August 2018.
- ✓ There were 18 ground breakers who were enlisted to prepare the ground for the truth to be shared. These consisted of men and women from all around the country gathered for this purpose.
- ✓ During this time:
 - ✓ About 1022 Bible Studies were conducted.
 - ✓ <u>1,389 persons and families</u> were prayed with.
 - ✓ Over <u>11,789 Untold Truth fliers</u> and <u>1,812 Health</u> Expo fliers were shared around that region
 - ✓ 11,198 tracts were distributed
 - √ About 4,475 contacts collected



2 HEALTH EXPO

- ✓ The Health Expo ran for 3 weeks, beginning on the 5th August, 2018.
- ✓ The Health Expo started a week before the Evangelistic campaign began and lasted all through the program.
- √ The Health Expo program consisted of two different sections
 - Daily health lectures: Which were practical sessions held from 9am through 12pm
 - Daily health screening: The health screening took place from 12pm through 4pm






✓ The Health Expo program included medical checks and useful information on the NEWSTART (Nutrition, Exercise, Water, Sunshine, Temperance, Air, Rest and Trust in God) doctors.



2 HEALTH EXPO

- ✓ The Health also included a free eye screening opportunity which also included giving away some free glasses.
- √ 120 patients were attended to by the Eye clinic for three consulting days
- √ 35 bifocal lenses with frames was given free
- √ 15 patients got free ophthalmic frames after the clinical examinations
- √ There was Glaucoma screening for each of the over 120 patients
- ✓ Subjective refraction was done for 85% of the patients.
- ✓ Prevalent Eye conditions diagnosed during the outreach:
 - ✓ 1. Refractive Errors
 - ✓ 2. Presbyopia
 - ✓ 3. Primary Open Angle Glaucoma.
 - ✓ 4. Corneal Opacity.
 - ✓ 5. Senile cataract





TWO-BY-TWO

- A Every day, the missionaries were sent out in pairs to hostels, shops and bars to share the Three Angel's messages with the people of Calabar.
- An average of 200 Bible studies were given on a daily basis to the community.
- An average of 400 persons were prayed for each day during the two-by-two evangelism and invitation calls were extended to these people to attend the evening program.
- A The two-by-two evangelism lasted for 3 hours daily.





4 CLASSROOM EVANGELISM

- ✓ As the evangelistic campaign began, the classroom evangelism method was used to invite people for the program and share tracts/ fliers.
- √ 5 volunteers were deployed for this line
 of Bible work.
- ✓ Permission was sought from Lecturers and then before the students already seated for a lecture, a promotion of the ongoing evangelistic program was done.
- A megaphone was purchased and used for this purpose.



PROSPECT CALL CENTER (PCC)

A Some missionaries were assigned to call visitors, prospects and newly baptized members on a daily basis.

⚠ They prayed on the phone and encouraged the visitors who had previously attended the program to keep coming.

▲ They also sent good will messages by SMS.







MEDIA EVANGELISM (RADIO JINGLES)

- ✓ There were radio jingles sounded on the local Calabar radio station.
- ✓ This created a massive awareness within Calabar Town and university.









- ✓ Every night, from August 12th-25th, an average of 200 adults came out to listen to the Word of God proclaimed at University of Calabar, Calabar town.
- ✓ God spoke words of salvation to the people of Calabar town through His servant – Pastor Godswill MENSAH.
- ✓ The evening program was streamed live, so that people all over the world were able to watch the program.







- ✓ Every night, students from a neighboring special needs school (for the deaf and dumb) also attended the health expo and the nightly outreach meetings at the University of Calabar, Calabar town.
- ✓ The Lord used an interpreter to get through to them each night and 4 of these special friends choose to join the church through baptism.







Based on the results of the Demographic survey, some unique messages specially prepared for the people of Calabar town were:

- ✓ The Untold truth about speaking in Tongues
- ✓ The Untold truth about good and evil angels
- ✓ The Mark of the Beast and Seal of God
- ✓ The Untold truth about Law and Grace
- √ Why many Denominations







Before each evening sermon began, short and interesting talks were delivered, such as health talks, academic excellence talks etc.

- ✓ The health talks were delivered by the Medical missionaries represented by Bro Faith Ogbonnaya
- √ The academic excellence talks were delivered by Dr Benita Amos
- ✓ An interesting talk on the facts about and care of the eye was also given by Dr Andy Ebere





OTHER ACTIVITIES

TRAINING SESSIONS

To equip the missionaries, training and Bible study was conducted using excerpts from the FAST Discipleship kit - a practical bible study series on discipleship, emphasizing Bible Memorization.

The training covered two modules viz: Basic

Training and Team Tactics.

BIBLE STUDY SESSIONS

To further equip the missionaries for their daily two-by-two Bible study with prospects, more Bible study was conducted using the Good News Bible Study pack. The topics were chosen to harmonize with the Evening outreach sermon.

The topics treated are as outlined:

Day 1: The Goodnews About the Bible

Day 2: The Goodnews About the End of Suffering.

Day 3: The Goodnews About The Man Who Was God.

Day 4: The Goodnews About Baptism.

Day 5: The Goodnews About Good and Evil Angels

Day 6: The Goodnews About God's Everlasting Grace (the ten commandments)

Day 8: The Goodnews About the Creator.

Day 9: The Goodnews About God's Unchangeable day

Day 10: The Mark of the Beast.

Day 11: The Goodnews About the Comforter.

Day 12: The Goodnews About Death

Day 13: The Goodnews About God's People.



PRAYING WITHOUT CEASING

AMissionaries were encouraged to pray with at least 5 people everyday.

AVolunteers found physical, spiritual and mental strength through prayers, fasting and trust in God. Solutions to many problems came solely through the power of our prayers.

ALIVE-Nigeria members who couldn't attend the missions, formed a 24/7 prayer chain. They prayed round the clock for 2 weeks.



COMMUNITY SERVICE

A The missionaries identified two urgent needs of the community:

- 1. One was the need to fill the muddy spots on the student passageway beside the tent where the evangelism meetings were held.
- 2. The need to clean the market place.

MEAL TIMES

AMeal times were happy times. Vegetarian meals were served twice everyday.

AFood items were donated by missionaries. They sourced what food items they could from their various locations.

ASome missionaries volunteered to serve as official Caterers for ALIVE-Nigeria. They prepared our very tasty and healthy vegetarian meals.

AThe caterers also taught other missionaries how to prepare some vegetarian meals.



SABBATH WORSHIP




- During the Sabbath School worship, we had several study units and a separate class for all our visitors and baptismal candidates.

A mobile baptistery previously bought, was used at this program. As a result, baptisms were conducted several times in the second week.










BAPTISM


